Lead Proctors

- read the testing script to students
- in charge of test security
- one-hour training session required
- 1 needed for each testing room

Proctors

- low-stress
- help with student check-in
- make sure students are testing appropriately
- detailed written instructions are provided
- no training session required
- 1-7 needed for each testing room

In general, the required time for these roles will be from 7:15am to 12:15pm for morning exams and from 11:15am to 4:15pm for the afternoon exams. The actual ending time will vary depending on the length of the exam.
